The national consultant's responsibilities include:

- To collect background information and conduct a short desk review of relevant project documents
- To pro-actively provide relevant local knowledge and insights to the international consultants
- To assist in identifying the local partners of ongoing and past projects and their beneficiaries in the target areas to enhance the inclusiveness of the evaluation
- To organize and take part in the interviews with key stakeholders
- To take notes during interviews, provide a summary of notes and/or write brief reports on main observations and conclusions
- To write certain sections in the draft report if requested by the lead evaluator
- Provide interpretation (Arabic-English / English-Arabic)
- English to Arabic translation of documents (e.g. survey, factsheets and/or any other document required).

Qualifications of the team member:

- Tunisian nationality with relevant qualifications in Economics and Social sciences, and/or Development studies
- Knowledge, skills, and experience (at least five years) in the area of M&E and independent evaluation of International Cooperation programmes / projects
- Knowledge and experience (at least five years) of private sector development with a special focus on small and medium enterprises in developing countries
- Knowledge of local context
- Knowledge of other related local programmes/projects, and of associated local institutions and government structures will be a great asset.
